*School to Add New Certificate Program, Medical Insurance Billing and Office Administration*

The school will open for classes on Monday, April 27. The Krafft Road location replaces the current campus at 3568 Pine Grove Avenue in Port Huron.

Dan Krumenaker, R.N. and business manager for Cardiology Associates of Port Huron said, “Ross students that come to us for their externship are ready to work as entry-level medical assistants.” Krumenaker adds that as the area ages, the need for medical care and qualified medical assistants is increasing. “We’re very fortunate to have Ross in the community. Their students are eager to learn and gain more knowledge about cardiology.” He estimates that the practice has hired approximately eighty-five percent of Ross grads who have served an externship there.

### **Programs in Port Huron**

The Port Huron campus currently offers a medical assistant program and will begin offering a medical insurance billing and office administration (MIBOA) program in May. Students receive a certificate for each program upon completion. The MIBOA coursework includes instruction on billing, coding, working with insurance claim submissions and understanding Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliance, as well as health insurance regulations. All prospective students must have a high school diploma or a
